Welcome back from break! Here are some important upcoming dates:

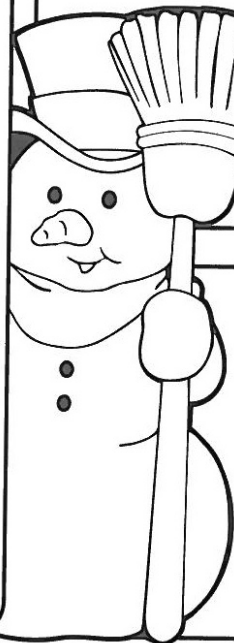
- Monday, January 19th: no school, Martin Luther King Day
