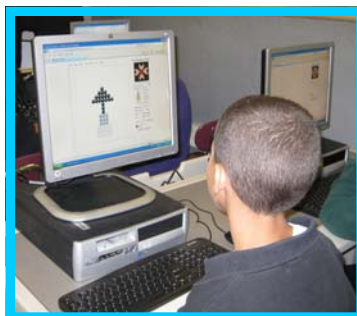
## The Third Grade printed Fish!
