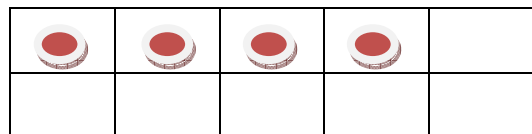

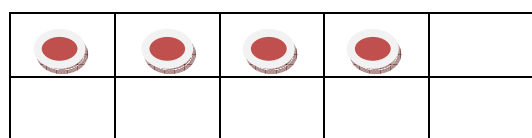

More Than:

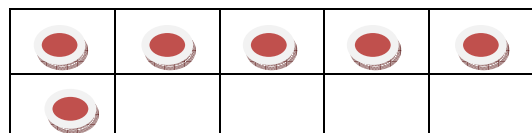


4 and 1 more is _____ (answer = $4 + 1 = 5$)

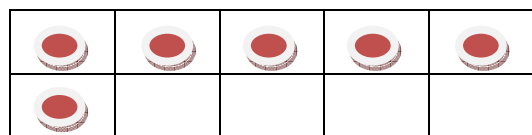


4 and 2 more is _____ (answer = $4 + 2 = 6$)

Fewer Than:



1 fewer than 6 is _____ (answer = $6 - 1 = 5$)



2 fewer than 6 is _____ (answer = $6 - 2 = 4$)

Place numbers in order from least (few) to greatest (most)

7, 12, 5 = 5, 7, 12

Recognizing which of the given 2 numbers in fewer/more: use bottoms to show the numbers

5 is **fewer** than 9

8 is **more** than 3

2 is fewer than 7

11 is more than 6
