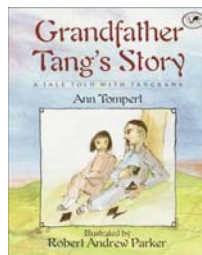
This month.....

In math we have been having lots of fun learning geometry!!

While learning about solid figures the students made their own figures. After they constructed them they counted and compared the number of flat surfaces, vertices and edges.
