This week the students got a chance to see what is expected of them for the NYS ELA Test this spring by taking last year's test. We will be going over this in class and I will send the tests home for you to review. Be sure to check your child's folder between now and the test for practice prep. Next week will be reading "If You Made a Million," by David M. Schwartz. This story will show us a deeper meaning of money and what it is.

On Wednesday, 10/14, we will be going to Landis Arboretum to explore the forest. In Science we have been learning about different types of leaves and types of forests - deciduous and coniferous.
