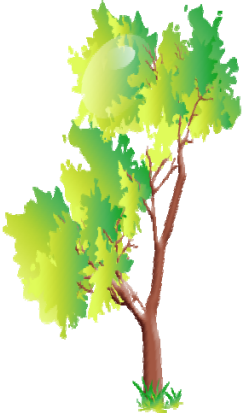


4th Grade's Day At Camp Chingachgook

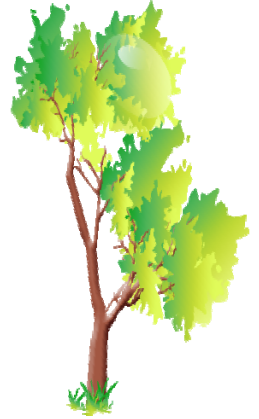
